Slavín National Mausoleum Tour

K rotundě 1, 128 00 Praha 2 – Vyšehrad

The [Slavín National Mausoleum Tour](#) offers participants a guided exploration of one of Prague's most significant historic sites. It engages with themes of memory, identity, and the architecture of commemoration, presenting the mausoleum not only as a burial site for Czech cultural and national elites, but also as a living landscape of evolving societal values. The tour includes commentary on symbolic design, reflections on the socio-political context of its creation and a recent educational project in which students analyzed the site and its history to make proposals for its future expansion.
