The [Reina Sofia Museum](#) is Spain's national museum of contemporary art. Focusing primarily on Spanish art, it houses many works of Salvador Dali and Picasso, *Guernica*. Located in the 'Golden Triangle of Art' including the Museo del Prado and the Museo Thyssen-Bornemisza, it is in the centre of the city. In 2005 it was extended by the award winning French architect Jean Nouvel. Delegates are invited to meet from 7pm onwards. You can meet directly in the Jean Nouvel designed [NuBel Restaurant-Café](#), or visit the museum and join us later in the evening.

All food and drinks are individually priced. Entrance to the museum is free of charge between 7pm and 9pm

## La Terraza de Atenas Parque de Atenas

La Parque de Atenas is a public open space with no closing time.  
La Terraza Atenas is open until 2.30am.

[La Terraza Atenas](#) was originally part of the Royal Court of Philip II from 1590. Near the River Manzanares, the Royal Palace, the Royal Opera House, it has direct views of the Cathedral. An open air cocktail bar, it serves Spanish tapas. If you wish to have a full meal, it is advisable to eat before hand or later. It is located inside [La Parque de Atenas](#) that the local government of Madrid includes lists as part of the city's Patrimonio Verde.
