Focusing on contemporary Spanish art, the Reina Sofia Museum houses works by Dali and Picasso, including *Guernica*. Located in the 'Golden Triangle of Art' encompassing the Museo del Prado and the Museo Thyssen-Bornemisza, it is in the centre of the city. In 2005 it was extended by the French architect Jean Nouvel. Delegates are invited to visit the museum from 7pm onwards and meet in the Jean Nouvel designed [NuBel Restaurant-Café](#) at anytime after that.

El Mercado San Miguel functions as a food market and a place for tapas and Spanish wines. Open 10am until 1pm.

The [Mercado de San Miguel](#) is Madrid's most famous and popular gourmet food market. Located in the historic heart of the city just steps from the **Plaza Mayor**, it operates as an upscale, bustling indoor food hall where visitors can sample a massive variety of Spanish culinary specialties.

Given its location next to Plaza Mayor, there are multiple other places to eat and drink nearby if delegates prefer to sample the full range of opportunities in the area. Nb. It is a tapas bar, so seating is limited.
